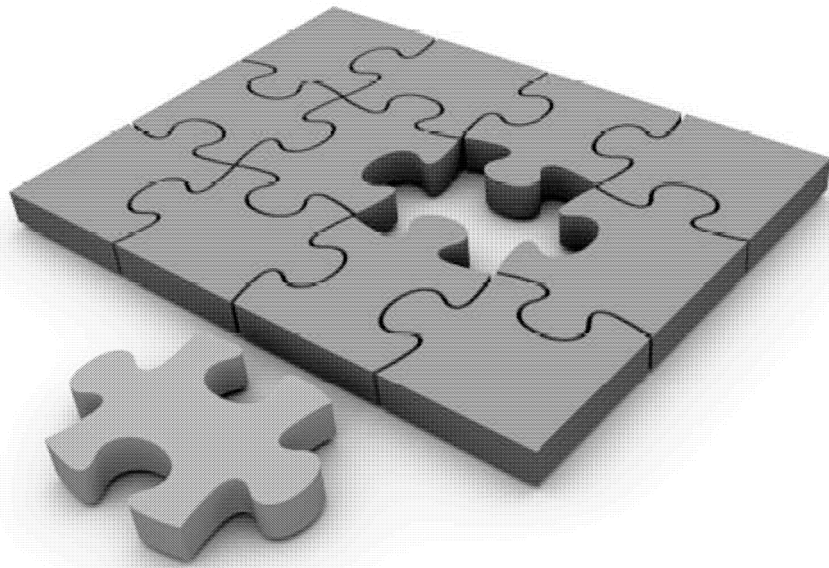

## Living a godly life in an ungodly world

- 1) What do you understand is meant in 4:16,23 & 25 by “seven times” passing by?
- 2) What is the central reason that Daniel gives for God ‘cutting down’ Nebuchadnezzar?
- 3) What is the difference between Christian contentment and sinful pride? How did this difference show itself in Nebuchadnezzar's life?
- 4) At first glance this passage might indicate that God's actions are purely judgement on a godless king. *Is there anything in these verses that indicates any other purpose?*
- 5) After Daniel explains Nebuchadnezzar's dream, he tactfully offers the king some advice in verse 27. *Does this suggest that God's plans may not be set in concrete?*
- 6) In following Daniel's advice to the end that “*it may be that then your prosperity will continue*”, what would the king in effect be acknowledging?
