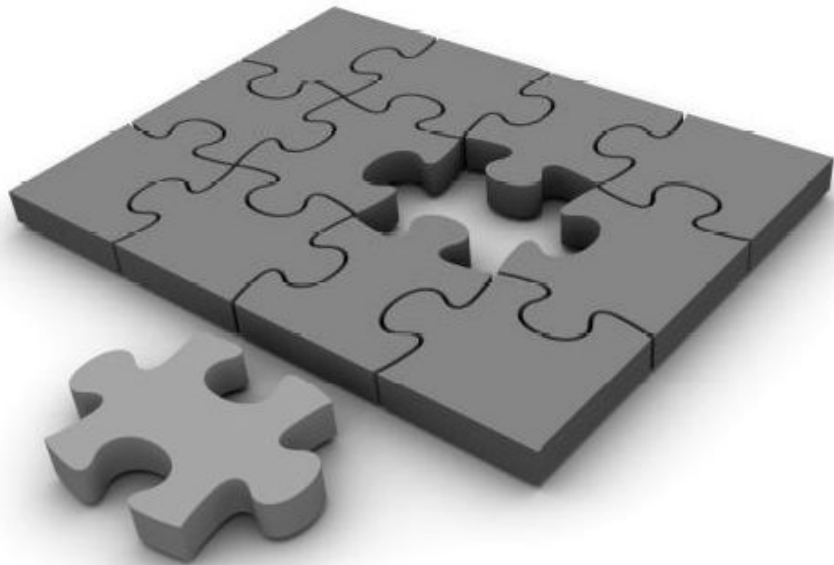


Studies in Daniel – (Study 24) “That very night...”

- 1) In verse 24 we have the declaration ‘therefore he sent the hand...’ *How would you summarise from verses 18-23 what the issues are that bring about the message of judgement on the wall?*

Daniel now proceeds to explain the meaning of the writing on the wall.

- 2) What does verse 26 reveal about the general theme of the book of Daniel so far?
- 3) What does the weighing on the scales of verse 27 tell us about how God dealt with Belshazzar?
- 4) The interpretation of the first two words leads to the inevitable consequence as explained in verse 28. *What would you consider to be the key word in this verse and what does it demonstrate about both God and the recipients of His judgement?*
- 5) What was Belshazzar’s reaction to what Daniel had told him?
- 6) What do the words ‘that very night’ reveal?

When Babylon fell, it was reported that not even a spear was thrown. Although Belshazzar and a few others were executed, no battle occurred because the invasion happened so fast.
