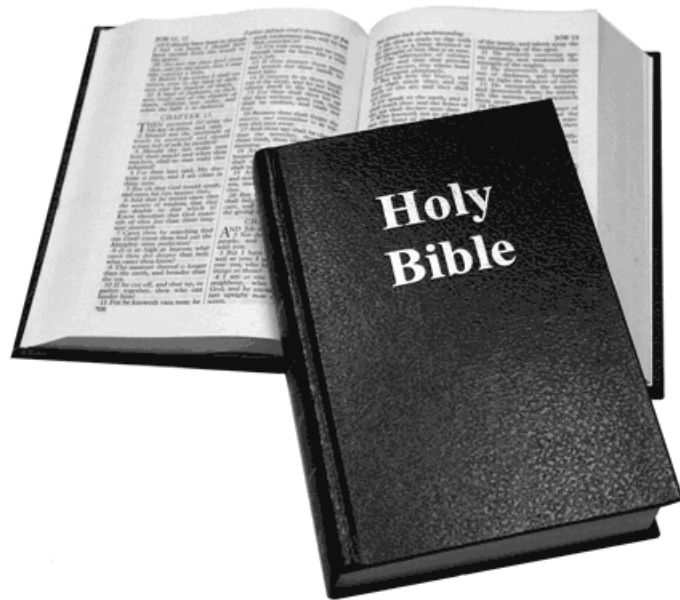


Studies in John – (Study 4) *“The Word became flesh”*

Reading: John 1:14-18

“The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us.’ This statement is one of the most significant and memorable ever penned. Its implications are limitless” (Milne)

- 1) Consider the opening phrase of verse 14 quoted above. *Look again at how the opening verses of the chapter describe ‘The Word’ and discuss the wonder of what it meant for Jesus to come into the world.*
- 2) John continues in verse 14 with the phrase ‘we have seen His glory’. *What is the significance of this statement?*
- 3) What does John mean when he says of Jesus that he “*came from the Father, full of grace and truth*”?
- 4) What does verse 16 mean when it talks about us receiving “*the fullness of His grace*”?
- 5) What does verse 17 tell us about the part Jesus played in God’s unfolding purposes in salvation throughout the Bible?
- 6) Verse 18 takes us back to the theme of revelation. *What key truths come out of this one verse?*
