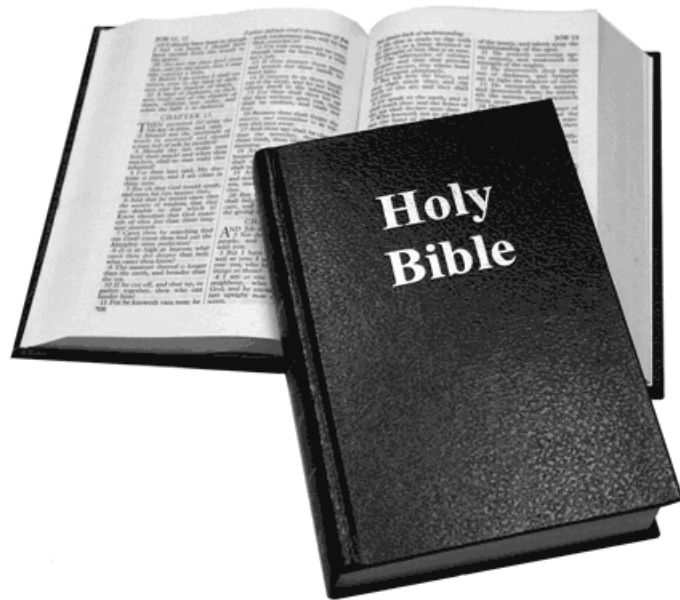


## Studies in John – (Study 8) “Come and see”

Reading: John 1:43-51



*“These things are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ...”*

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study notes  
Tuesday 8th / Wednesday 9th December

John chapter 1 has included the record of the events of four consecutive days; the last of which we consider in this study. Immediately in verse 43 we are reminded that it is Christ who comes to find us; not the other way round. He came to seek and to save the lost (Luke 19:10)!

- 1) What do we know about Philip and what will he be remembered for most?
- 2) Verse 45 reveals how much of Christ there is in the Old Testament. *Why was this important to Philip and Nathanael then, and why should it matter to us today?*
- 3) Verse 46 is a key verse for Nathanael. *What did he mean by his comment about Nazareth and why was Philip's advice so good?*
- 4) The response of Jesus to Nathanael in verse 47 seems rather strange. *What did Jesus mean?*
- 5) What do verses 48 and 49 reveal about Nathanael's growing understanding about Jesus?
- 6) In verses 50-51 what are the 'greater things' that Nathanael will see?
