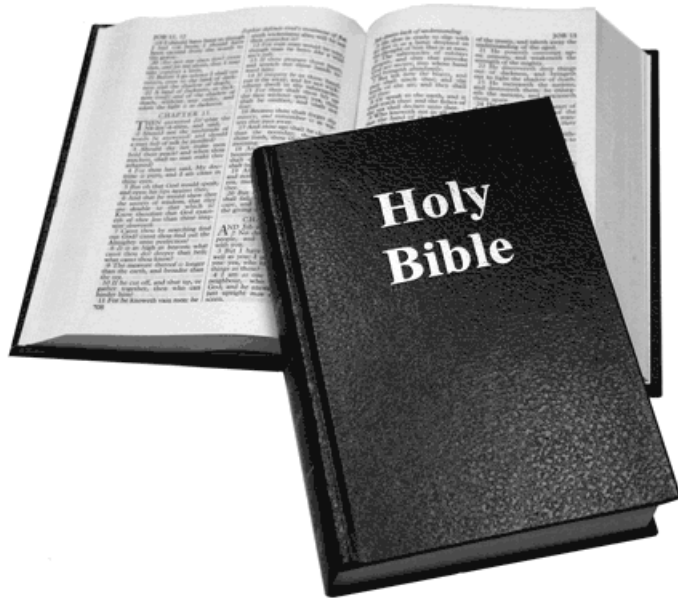


Studies in John – (Study 11) “He came to Jesus...”

Reading: John 3:1-3

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study notes
Tuesday 9th / Wednesday 10th February

- 1) Verse 1 introduces us to Nicodemus. *What can we discern about him from the two bits of information given?*
- 2) Many ideas have been put forward as to why Nicodemus came to Jesus at night. *What do verses 1 and 2 reveal about his reasons?*
- 3) From verses 2 and 3, what level of understanding of who Jesus is has Nicodemus reached at this point?
- 4) We might expect Jesus to tell Nicodemus that no-one could know their sins forgiven unless they were born again. *Why it is significant that Jesus refers to seeing the Kingdom of God?*
- 5) How would you explain to an unbeliever what it means to be born again?
- 6) The question often asked is whether Nicodemus was ever born again. *What evidence later in John points to an answer to this question?*
