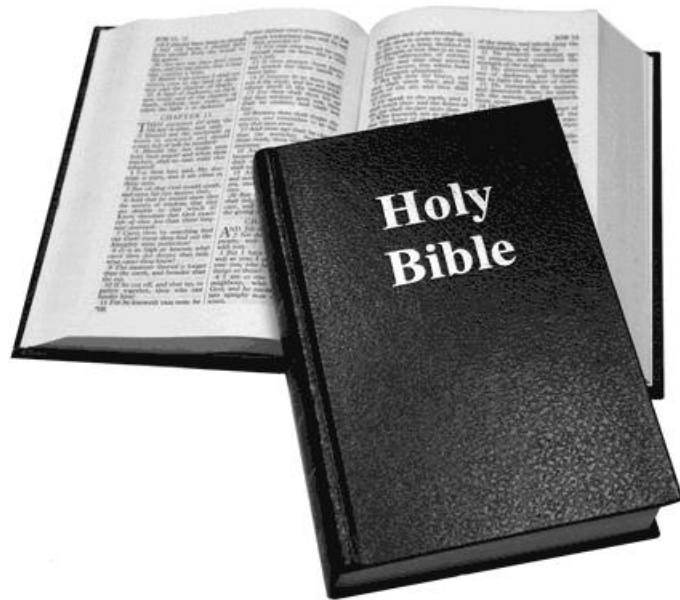


Studies in John – (Study 16)  
*“Everyone is going to Him”*

Reading: John 3:22-26



*“These things are written so  
that you may believe that  
Jesus is the Christ...”*

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study notes

After His encounter with Nicodemus, Jesus now embarks on a more general teaching and preaching ministry. As a result there were those who responded and were baptised.

- 1) At first glance we find a throw-away comment in verse 24. *Why do you think it is included in this passage?*
- 2) In verse 22, what is the significance in Jesus now getting involved in baptism?
- 3) We understand baptism in respect of the death and resurrection of Christ. *How are we then to explain the baptism that is going on here?*
- 4) What do you think the argument was about in verse 25?
- 5) Verse 26 includes a strange comment: “that man who was with you on the other side of the Jordan”. *What does that reveal about the stage things have reached at this point?*
- 6) At the end of verse 26 we find the phrase “everyone is going to Him”. *What does this show us is happening to John’s ministry and why is it a problem to his followers?*
