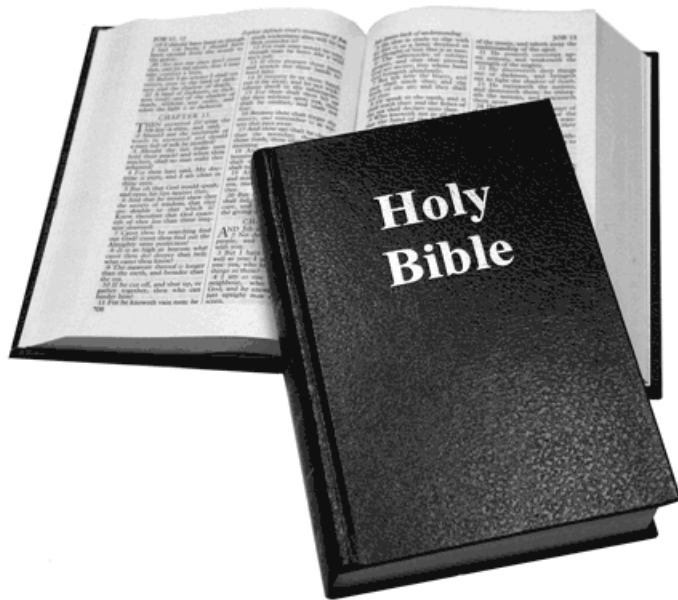


Studies in John – (Study 17)

- 1) What point is John making in verse 27?
- 2) In verse 28 we see the transparency of John’s ministry. *What does this verse say about John and the importance of what he did and said?*
- 3) In verse 29 John uses the illustration of a wedding. *Who is he suggesting are the bride and the bridegroom; and what is the significance of the role of the ‘best man’?*
- 4) What does John mean when he says that this joy *“is now complete”* (v29)?
- 5) What does verse 30 tell us about John’s approach to his calling?
- 6) Although we would not compare ourselves with John the Baptist, what does this passage teach us about our own witness for Christ?
