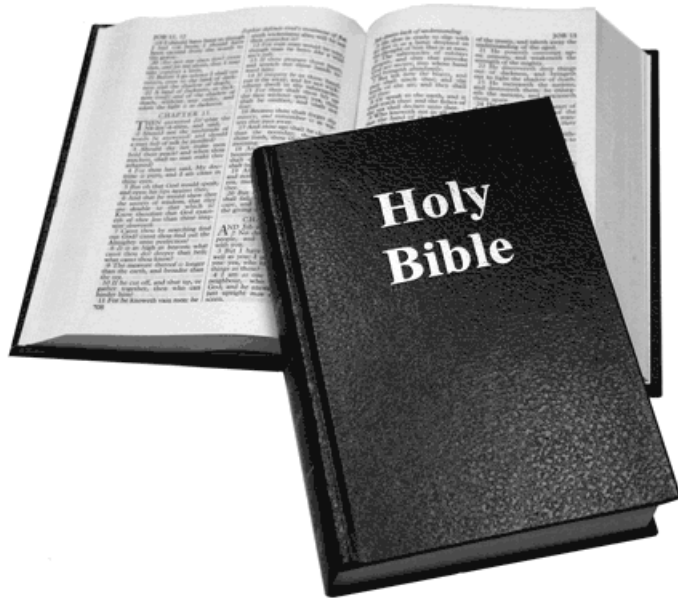


Studies in John – (Study 21)  
“Where can you get this living water?”

Reading: John 4:10-14



*“These things are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ...”*

Home Fellowship Group Bible Study notes

- 1) In verse 10 why does Jesus begin in this way rather than lay out the gospel in simple terms?
- 2) How would you describe what the ‘living water’ is that Jesus offers in this passage?
- 3) Why is the water ‘living’?
- 4) In verses 11-12 we find that the woman does still not know what Jesus is referring to. *What does she assume Jesus means?*
- 5) In verses 13-14 Jesus compares two lots of water. *What is his message behind this comparison?*
- 6) Notice that Jesus starts talking to this lady by speaking about something that was relevant to her before bringing it around to reveal her need of salvation. *What other examples of this can you think of in Jesus’ ministry and what can we learn about our own witnessing to others?*
