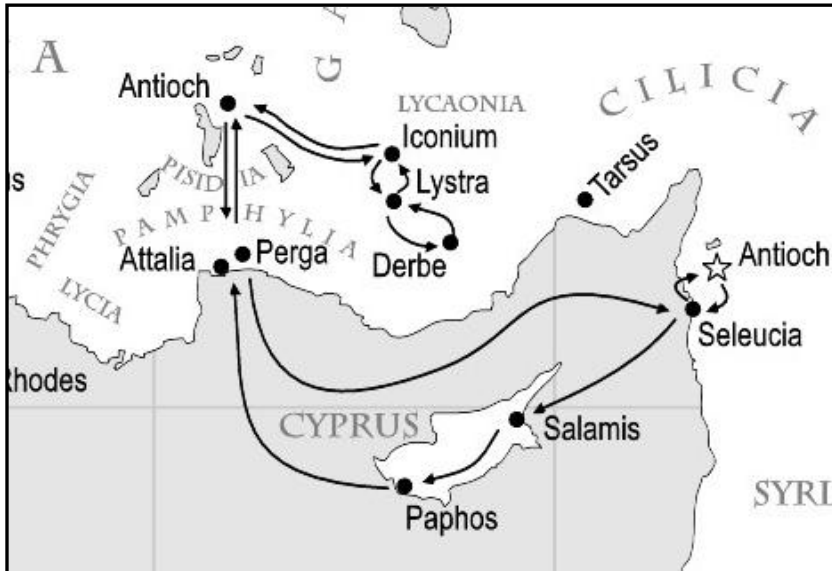


## Paul's First Missionary Journey – (Study 11)

- 2) What does verse 47 tell us about the purposes God had for His chosen people Israel?
- 3) What does Luke mean when he declares in verse 48 that *“all who were appointed for eternal life believed”*.
- 4) What does verse 49 tell us about how the gospel spreads?
- 5) Verse 50 seems to cast a cloud over the work Paul and Barnabas were doing and what happens introduces a recurring theme throughout the missionary journeys of Paul. *What is the significance of their response in verse 51?*
- 6) What does verse 52 tell us about the young church that Paul and Barnabas left behind in Pisidian Antioch?
