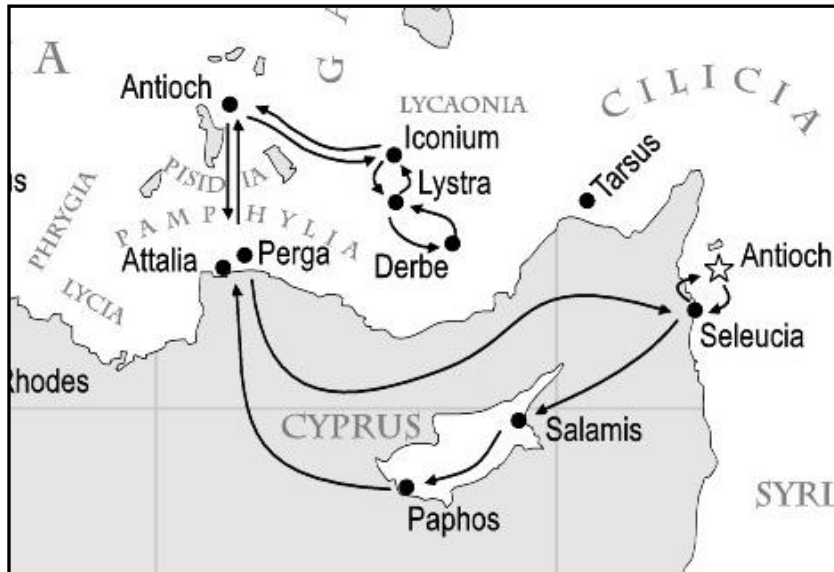


Paul's First Missionary Journey – (Study 13) *Whose God has come down in human form?*

- 1) What appears to be missing in Luke's introduction of this latest phase in the missionary journey and what can we conclude from it?
- 2) What in verse 9 is the correlation between what the lame man was doing and what Paul saw?
- 3) Was Paul using healing to preach the gospel or healing as he preached the gospel? Does this really matter?
- 4) The events of verse 10 show the importance of the detail Luke gives us in verse 8. *What is so significant about Paul's instruction and the lame man's response?*
- 5) How does the declaration of the crowd in verse 11 compare to the message that Paul and Barnabas are preaching?
- 6) What do verses 12 and 13 tell us about the nature of the people's religion?
