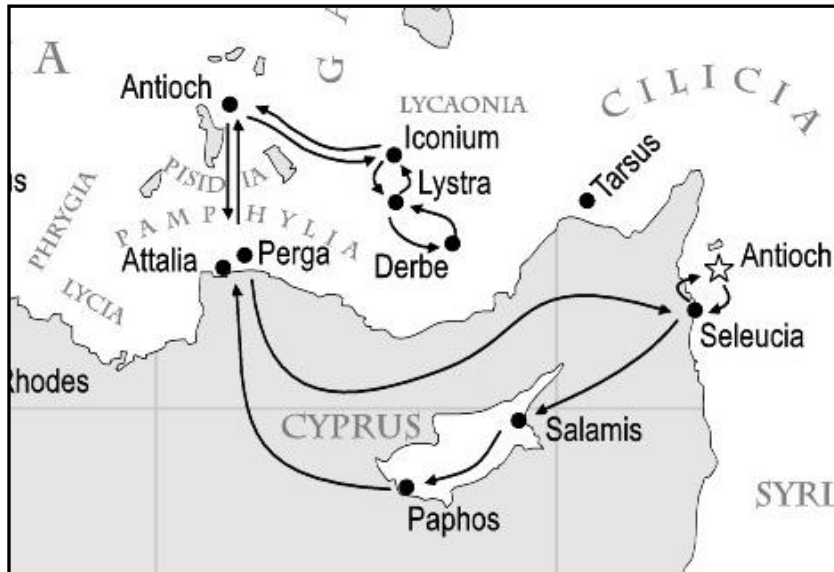


## Paul's First Missionary Journey – (Study 19) PRACTICAL APPLICATION PART 2

### Acts 13:1-3

1. When Paul and Barnabas went off to Antioch they evidently appointed leaders who would continue to look after the church in their absence. *Reading Eph 4:11-13 what is the role of Leadership in the church and how can we better promote it?*
2. Assessing the prayer life of the church at Antioch, what place should prayer have in our own church, and how can we ensure that it retains that place?

### Acts 14:26-28

3. Sometimes we are reluctant to consider that a particular work can ever be classed as ‘completed’. Surely Paul and Barnabas could have kept going further. *How can we see the positives in identifying a work in the church as being complete?*
4. How important is it to receive feedback from ministries in our own church and through the missionaries we support? How can we do this more effectively?
5. In what ways can we individually and collectively encourage Christian Workers who are back from the mission field, and those still out on the field?

### Acts 15:1-4

6. When the church is going on well it is inevitably open to attack. The church in Antioch seems to deal maturely with their particular challenge. *How can we make sure we are prepared for similar difficulties?*
