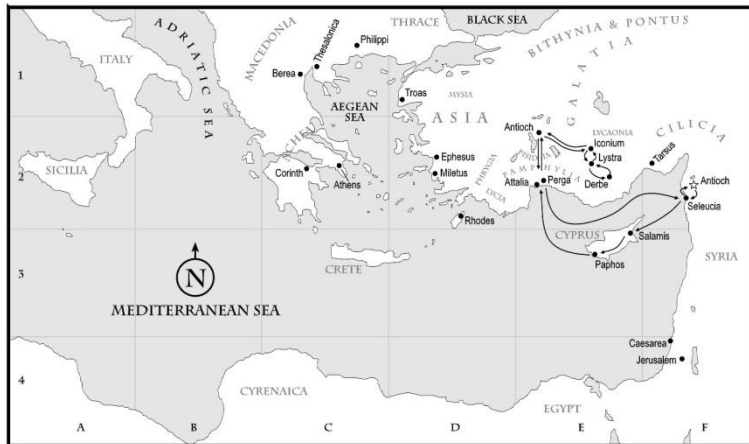


Paul's First Missionary Journey – (Study 3) *The Authentic Church*

- 4) What is striking about what we read in verse 29?
- 5) Giving is often seen as a taboo subject in churches today. *Why do you think that in the early church, where you might expect it to be a sensitive issue, it was addressed so openly?*
- 6) In what way would you say our passage reflects the extent of progress in the Antioch Church?
