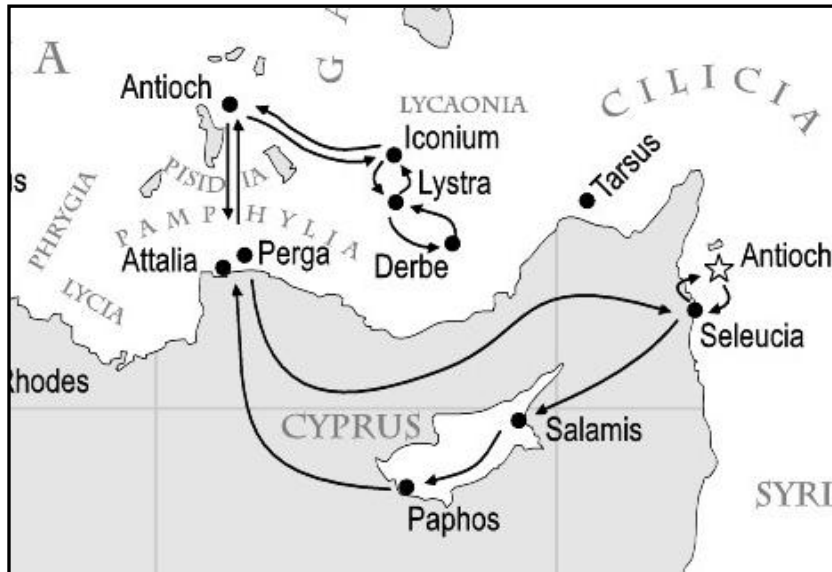


Paul's First Missionary Journey – (Study 9) “We tell you the good news”

Reading: Acts 13:29-38

- 1) Why is it important in verse 29 for Paul to refer to the people of Jerusalem carrying out all that was written about Jesus?
- 2) Why is a declaration of the resurrection of Christ to the Jewish listener so important?
- 3) In verse 32 Paul proceeds to declare what he calls ‘good news’. *What reasons does he give for this?*
- 4) In verses 34-35 Paul uses specific Old Testament scriptures to confirm Christ’s resurrection. *What does this suggest about his listeners’ understanding of the Old Testament?*
- 5) Why is Paul’s comparison between David’s death and that of Jesus so important?
- 6) The word ‘therefore’ which opens verse 38 brings all of this ‘looking back in scripture’ to its ultimate conclusion. *What part does forgiveness of sins play in the overall message of the gospel?*
